

# Bakery **BOOTCAMP**

The Bread Project provides a four-week intensive **Bakery Bootcamp**<sup>TM</sup> job training program in the fundamentals of commercial baking. The 115 hours of intensive training combines hands-on baking and soft/essential life skills instruction. The training supports persons who face barriers to employment and is free of cost to low income Bay Area residents. On completing the program, graduates receive their **Bakery Bootcamp** Certificate of Completion. Graduates also receive job placement assistance as well as 15 months of follow up service and support.

## UPCOMING BOOTCAMP TRAINING START DATES

### ELIGIBILITY

- 18 years or older, low income Bay Area resident
- Legally eligible to work in the United States
- Actively seeking employment (in next 30-60 days)
- Available Monday-Friday 9am – 3:30pm
- Have reliable transportation or access to public transportation for the entire program
- Able to function in a fast-paced mainly English speaking, and reading environment
- Access to stable housing for the duration of the program (i.e. shelter, transitional housing, Section 8, staying with family or friends, renting on one's own)
- Basic math skills and adequate reading abilities to complete assignments and work-related documents
- Able to see and read from 2.5 feet with or without reasonable accommodations
- Able to work standing for up to 8 hours, bend, twist, lift, carry objects, lift at least 25 pounds, and move quickly and safely in kitchen/food production area
- Able to hear in a noisy environment with or without reasonable accommodation

### REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Submit any one of the documents in each of the following categories to support your application

#### Photo Identification

- State ID Card
- Driver's License
- Passport

#### Proof of Eligibility to Work in U.S.

- Social Security Card
- U.S. Passport
- U.S. Birth Certificate
- Green Card
- Work Visa/Authorization

#### Proof of Income

- Paycheck
- Receipt of Public Assistance
- A letter if you receive any financial support (that is not wages) from another person

#### Proof of Address

(if your current address is different from your ID)

- Driver's License
- Bill for utility, phone or Internet
- Mail from the government, state/county agency
